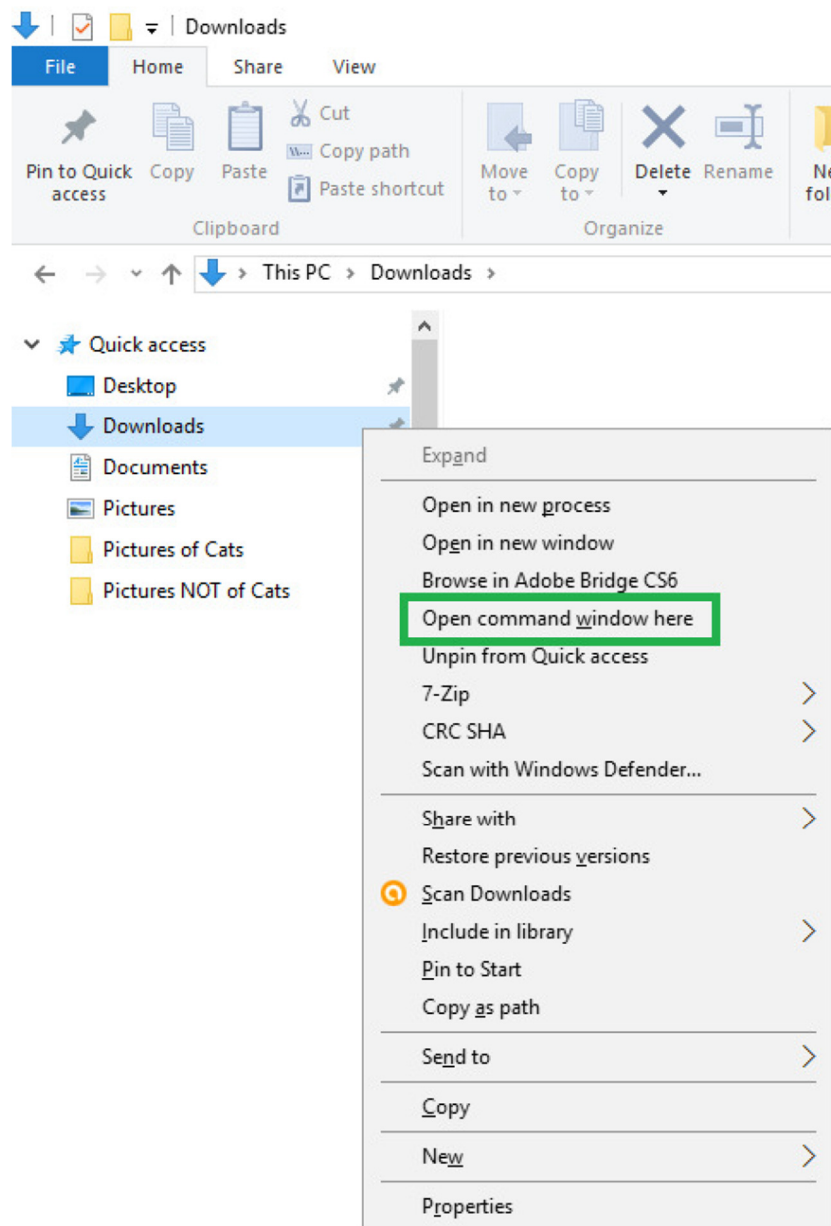


To install the 64 bit Microsoft Access Database Engine download [the installer here](#).


After the file has downloaded, open Windows Explorer (not Internet Explorer) by clicking the yellow folder on the taskbar.



In Windows Explorer, hold the Shift key while right-clicking on the Downloads folder, then click Open command window here. (If you have PowerShell instead of command window, jump below to the PowerShell section)



At the command prompt, type “AccessDatabaseEngine_x64 /passive” as shown and press enter.

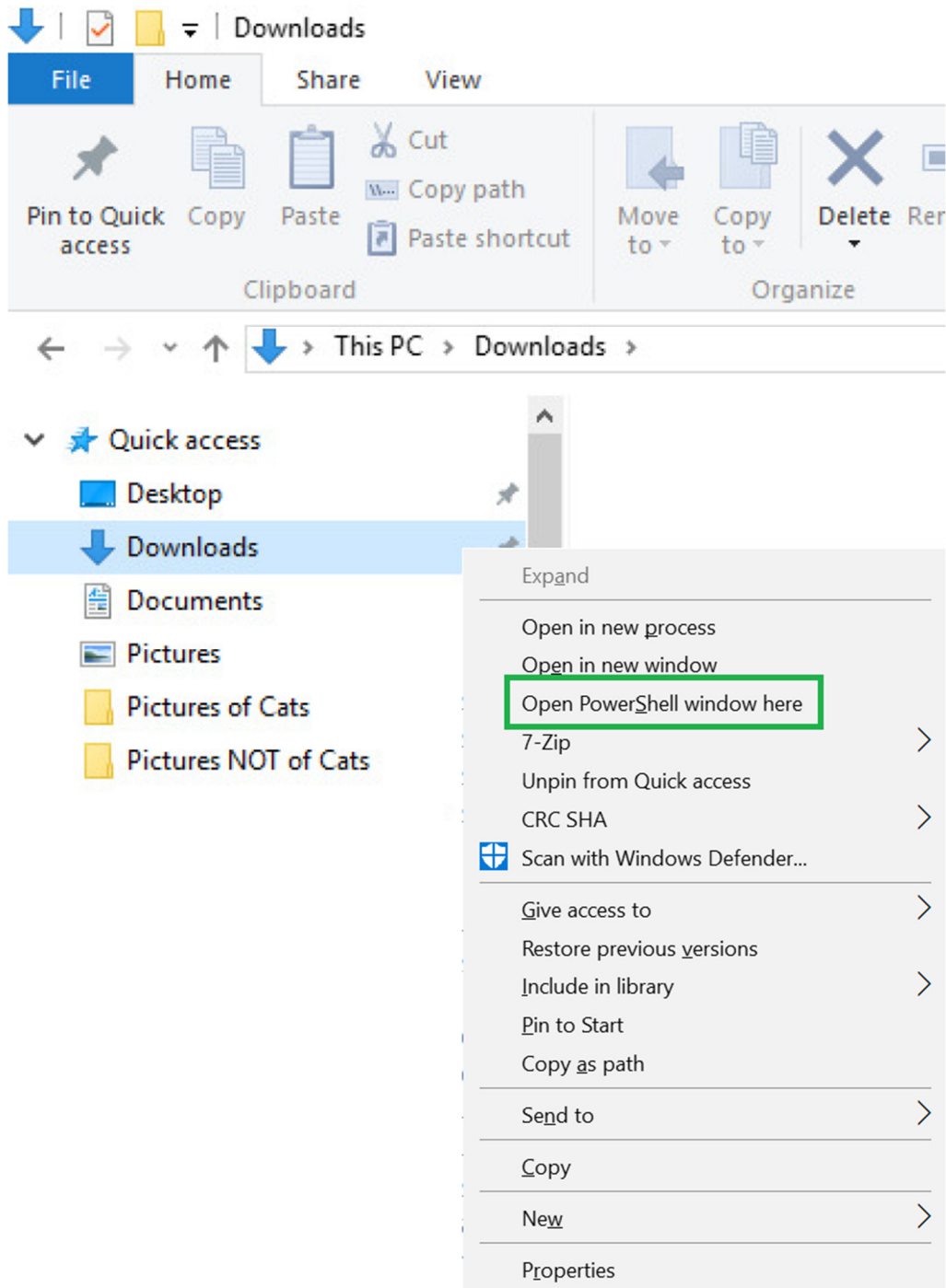

PowerShell



PowerShell functions much like Command Prompt in this scenario. Simply enter “./AccessDatabaseEngine_x64 /passive” as shown and press Enter.
